- obtaining conflict of interest disclosures from them

ABSTRACT FORMAT AND SUBMISSION

In order to submit your abstract, please use the platform accessible from the website <https://www.icds2019-paris.com/call-for-abstracts> and follow the steps.

- Following items are required:
 - Authors' Information
 - Preferred Abstract Presentation Format (oral, poster) - Final decision will be made by the Scientific Program Committee
 - Abstract Title in uppercase. The title should not exceed 200 characters
 - Abstract Topic. Please select the theme that best describes your abstract.
- Abstract should not exceed 2,000 characters including spaces (250 to 300 words) and should not include images or tables. Specific characters are allowed.
- The official language of ICDS2019 is English and there will be no translation services provided during the conference
- Abbreviations should be introduced before use. For example, "International Celiac Disease Symposium (ICDS)."
